SHELBY, N.C.— Medford (Ore.) Post 15 scored twice in the final three innings to edge Waipahu (Hawaii) Post 35 2-1 and win its American Legion World Series pool with a perfect 3-0 record.

Medford's Steen Fredrickson singled with one out in the ninth, moved to second on a Cole Carder single, then moved to third on an intentional walk. Teammate Jared Evans' fielder's choice to short-stop brought Fredrickson home with the winning run.

Medford (44-13) tied the game in the seventh when Carder drove home Eric Carlson. Waipahu (31-2) had taken a 1-0 lead in the top of the first on an error and Keka Rios' double.

Micah Brown got the win in relief for Medford, pitching 1.2 innings of scoreless ball. Tanner Atiburcio got the loss for Waipahu – which fell to 1-1 in pool play – pitching 8.2 innings and allowing both earned runs.

SHELBY, N.C.— Retif Oil (New Orleans) jumped on top of Chapin-Newberry (S.C.) Post 193 early and held on for a 5-2 win to move to 33-7 overall and 2-0 in pool play. The loss was the first of the season for Post 193 (29-1 overall, 1-1 in pool play).

Post 193 struck first when Danton Hyman bunted his way onto first, moved to second on a sacrifice and then took third on a wild pitch. Justin Hawkins then brought Hyman home on a groundout.

But Retif Oil took control from there, scoring two runs in the bottom of the first and two more in the second. Benjamin Hess drove in a run on a single and Scott Crabtree followed with a run-scoring double in the first.

In the second, Harrison Daste singled in a run, and Hess followed with another RBI three batters later. Retif would add another run in the bottom of the fifth on a Hayden Fuentes single.

Post 193 rallied with a run in the top of the seventh to close to 5-2 and put two runners on in the top of the ninth before a fly ball ended the game.

Brandon Briuglio picked up the win for Retif Oil, allowing six hits and two earned runs over seven innings.

BROOKLAWN, NEW JERSEY 10 RUNS NEBRASKA IN 7

Brooklawn (N.J.) Post 72 bounced back from its opening loss to route Omaha (Neb.) Fifty-Two's Patriots Post 374 15-1 in seven innings in Game 9 of The American Legion World Series. The Brookers (45-6, 1-1 in the ALWS) banded out 16 hits and bolted to an 8-0 lead after two innings.

Sean Breen, the 2014 American Legion Player of the Year, hit a three-run home run in the third inning and scored three times. Isaiah Easterling added three RBIs and scored twice, while Ray Taylor crossed the plate four times. Six other Brooklawn players batted in runs

Brooklawn starter Joe Bobiak pitched the first four innings, allowing three hits and one earned run.

Omaha's Calvin Rudolph was driven home by Garran Pauli in the third inning. Post 374 finished 0-3 in the ALWS and ended its year 41-20.
